



## **European Air Connectivity - Overview**




- Air connectivity recovery remains behind passenger traffic levels
- Only half of European countries exceeded their 2019 air connectivity levels
- Best performing countries vs. 2019 in EU+ market:
   1. GREECE 2. PORTUGAL 3. CYPRUS
- Significant gaps between direct and indirect connectivity = changed European aviation market structure - expansion of Ultra-Low-Cost Carriers and relative retrenchment of Full-Service Carriers.








