The U.S. Embassy in Athens is seeking to identify qualified insurance firms that are interested in providing health insurance services to an estimated 720 local employees, and eligible family members of the U.S. Embassy Athens, as follows:

- A. Basic Health Insurance Coverage for Civil Service Retirement (CSR) Fund Active Employees, and their eligible family members;
- B. Supplemental Health Insurance Coverage for Civil Service Retirement (CSR) Fund Annuitants and non-CSR Locally Employed (LE) Staff, and their eligible family members.
